REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN BYLAW NO. 418 – CONSOLIDATED

Being a bylaw to provide fire protection to a portion of the Electoral Area 'I' (Central Okanagan East Electoral Area) known as Ellison Fire Protection Service Area

WHEREAS the Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan established by Bylaw No. 418 cited as the "Ellison Fire Protection Local Service Establishment Bylaw No. 418, 1990", a local service for the purpose of providing fire protection to a portion of the Central Okanagan East Electoral Area "I".

NOW THEREFORE THE REGIONAL BOARD OF THE REGIONAL DISTRICT OF CENTRAL OKANAGAN IN OPEN MEETING ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The fire protection specified area created under Bylaw No. 168, cited as the "Ellison Fire Protection Specified Area Establishment and Loan Authorization Bylaw No. 168, 1979", as amended, is hereby established as a local service for that portion of Electoral Area 'I' as described in Schedule 'A' to this bylaw, and known as the Ellison Fire Protection Local Service Area.
- 2. The maximum amount that may be expended for annual operating costs for the service provided under Section One shall not exceed \$1.95 per \$1,000.00 of net taxable value of land and improvements within the service area.
- 3. The annual operating costs and debt servicing costs shall be recovered by requisition of monies to be collected by a property value tax levied on land and improvements for Regional Hospital purposes, within the service area.


4. The fire protection service established by this bylaw shall carry out all fire protection activities within the service area including but not limited to:

- a. fire suppression
- b. rescue
- c. disaster planning
- d. medical first responder program
- 5. The Regional Board of the Regional District of Central Okanagan is hereby authorized to enter into mutual aid agreements respecting the use of equipment and personnel to provide assistance inside or outside of the service area, to the specific clause of circumstances set out in Clause 4 of this bylaw, that may cause harm to persons and property.
